## THE PROJECT

The commission of the HBS campus plan was a collaborative study. DOBER LIDSKY MATHEY (DLM) was responsible for the coordination of three other professional firms working on various aspects of the plan, including detailed studies inarchitecture, engineering, delivery systems, and cost estimating.

## CHALLENGE

The School's and new Dean's charge to the consultant team requested a thorough facilities review and studies for reuse of existing buildings, as well as the siting of new buildings within an historic campus setting. The plan was seen as one aspect of moving the school to a renewed level of excellence.

## SOLUTION

The project team gathered detailed information on all aspects of the existing campus to usefully inform discussion of alternative development scenarios. School leadership, faculty, and students contributed their input to the evolution of the plan.

### RESULTS

The resulting framework plan forwarded proposals for new construction to support program initiatives enhancing Executive Education programs and campus life and residential opportunities for MBA students. Early projects, now completed, included expansion of the Executive Education accommodations and the construction of a new, and award winning, campus center for the MBA program. Projects for expansion and renovation of instructional spaces and residence hall renewal have also been undertaken.
