## THE PROJECT

An intensive examination of existing academic space involved study of utilization patterns of shared instructional spaces (labs and classrooms) and update and analysis of the academic space inventory.

Benchmarking analyses were prepared for campus facilities and departmental space allocations (dedicated spaces). These studies helped the College administration, Board of Trustees, and faculty define and prioritize academic space needs.

The study's data and analyses were used to determine the highest and best use for readapting a neighboring facility being acquired. In addition, the rationale for reassigning vacated space was recorded.
